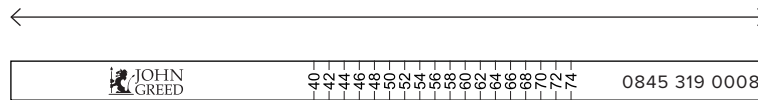


RING SIZE GUIDE

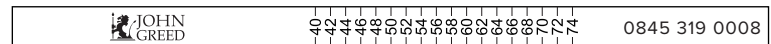

MEASURE YOUR RING SIZE

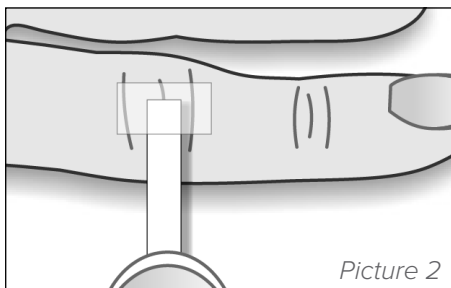
PICTURE 1

To measure your finger first cut out the size guide above as accurately as possible. Measure it end to end, it should be exactly 10cm.

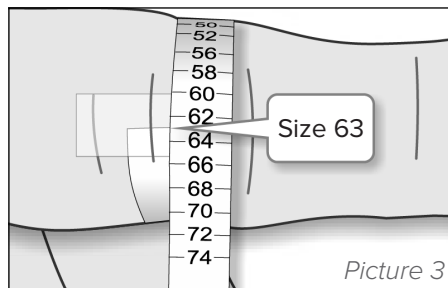


THIS BOX WHEN PRINTED SHOULD MEASURE 10CM



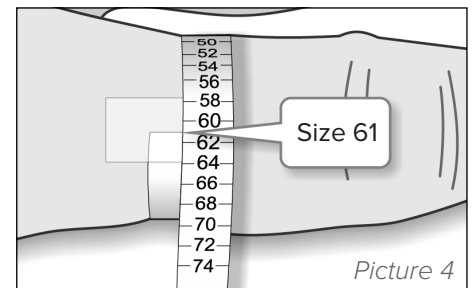
PICTURE 2

Stick a 2cm piece of sellotape on to the left hand end & stick to the middle of your knuckle.



PICTURE 3

Wrap the paper around your finger tightly & measure your knuckle size.



PICTURE 4

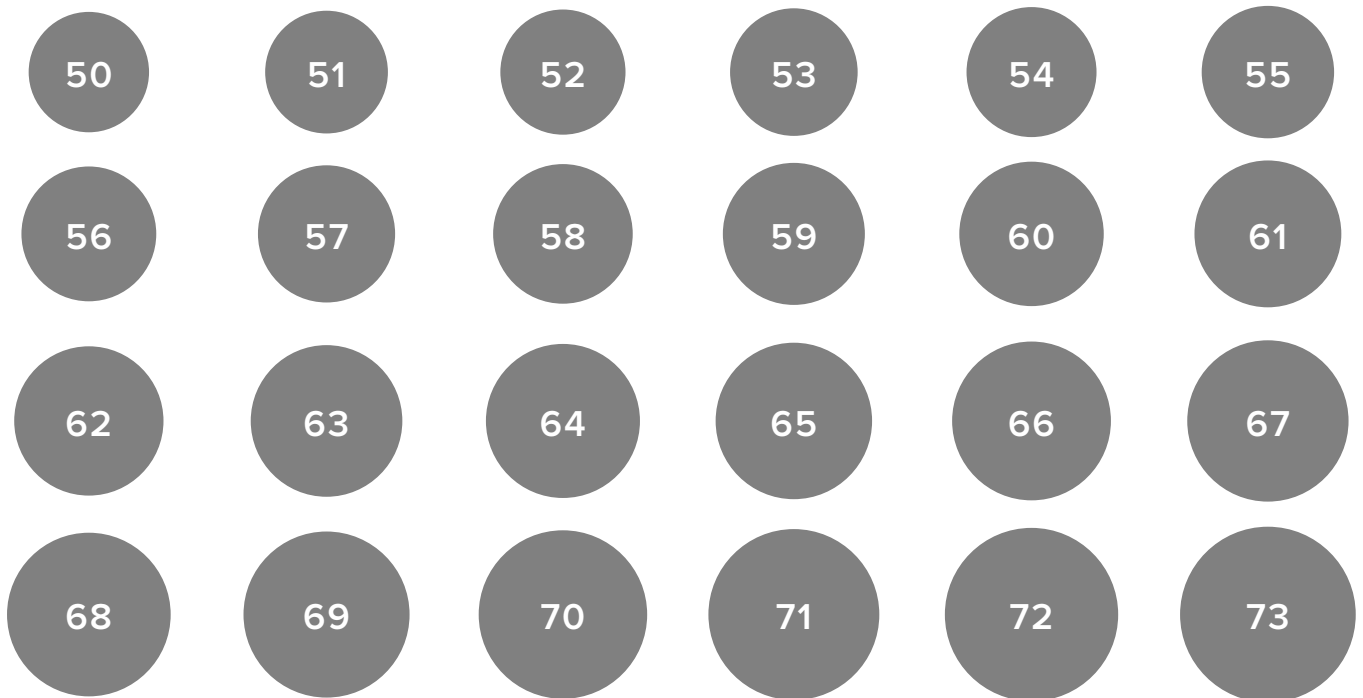
Do the same thing but this time where the ring would sit on your finger. Make a note of the measurements for discussion with us.

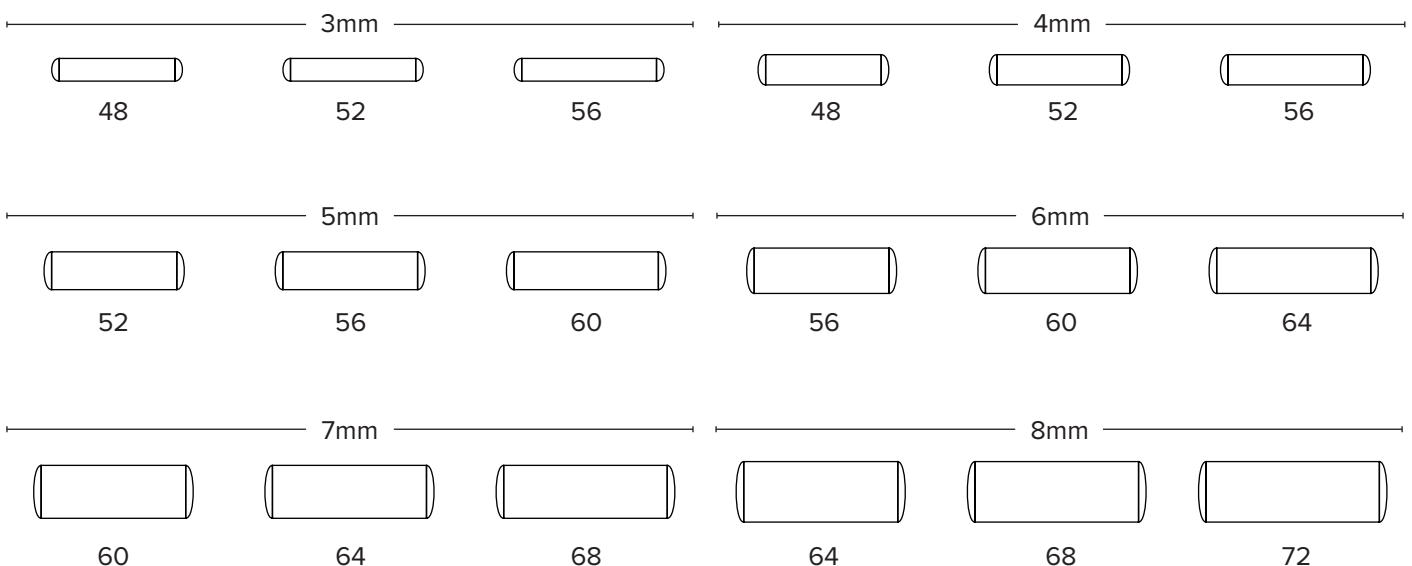
COMPARE YOUR RING SIZE

You can use the circles below to measure an existing ring. Place your ring on the circles. Don't get too close, about a foot away. Close one eye & don't move your head when 'sizing up'. Try & find the size where you can just see some white dots in the slightly 'jagged' digitised edge of the grey circle.



TIP: *If the inside of your ring is curved, add one to the size.*

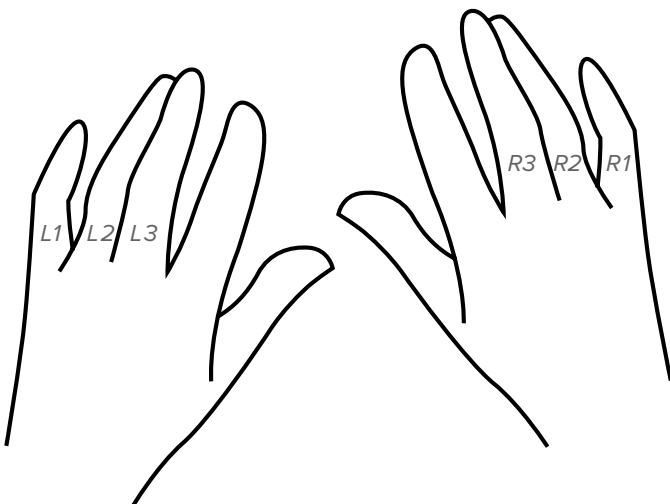
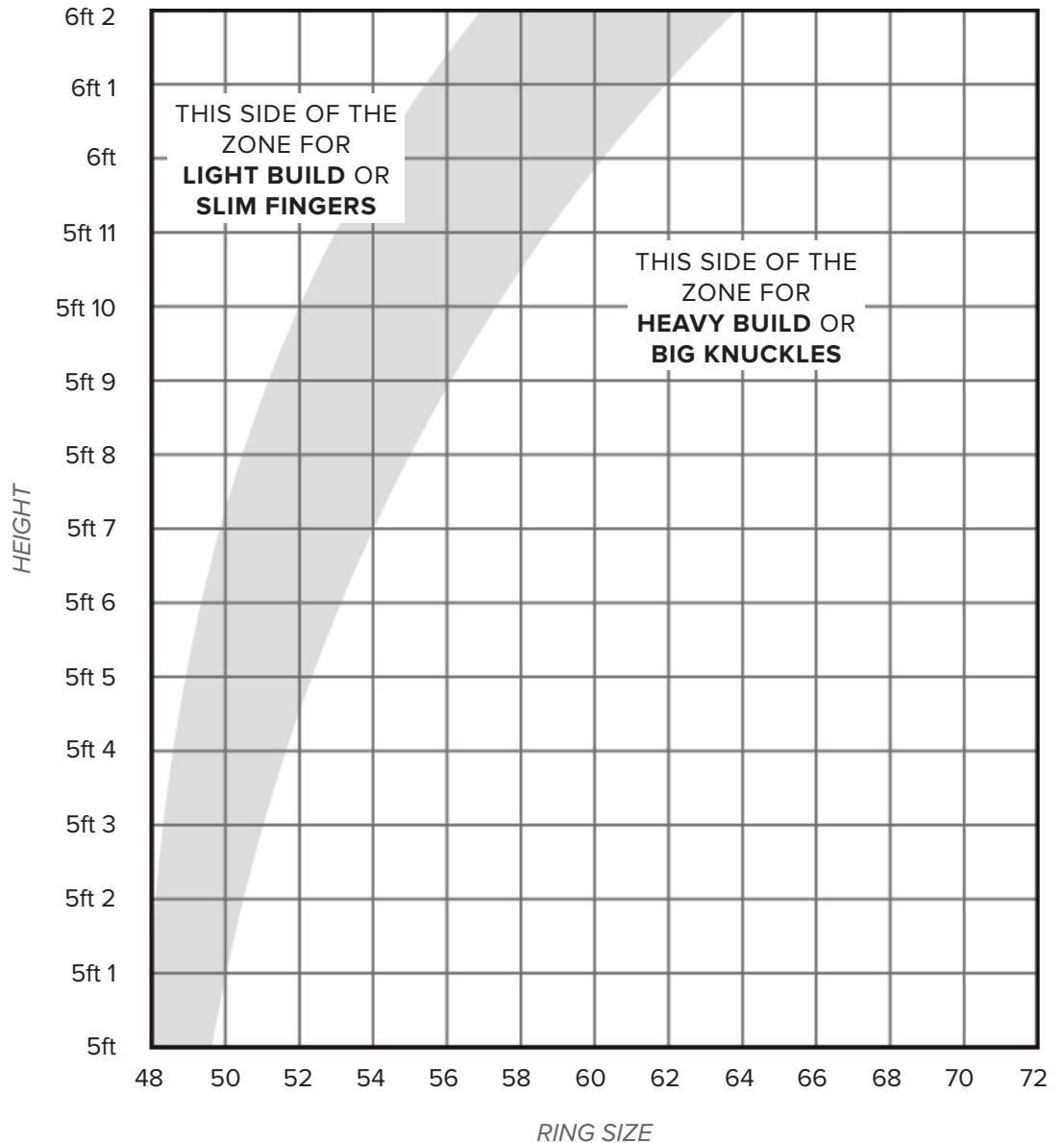
VIEW RING DEPTH



ESTIMATE A RING SIZE

If you want to find out someone's ring size from just their height and build you can use the following method to estimate it:

1. On the graph start by finding their height and move across to the grey 'size' zone.
2. Estimate which side of the zone they are in terms of build and knuckle size.
3. Drop down to find wedding ring finger size.
4. Use the multiplication factor below to find the size of a different finger.

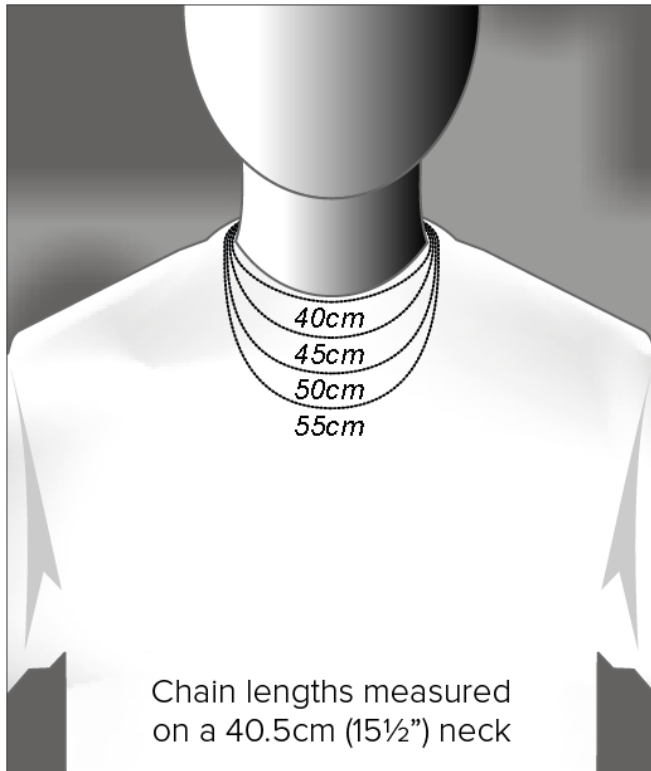


FINGER	L1	L2	L3	R1	R2	R3
MULTIPLY BY	0.9	1	1.1	1.14	1.05	0.93

PLEASE NOTE: *This applies only to right handed people*

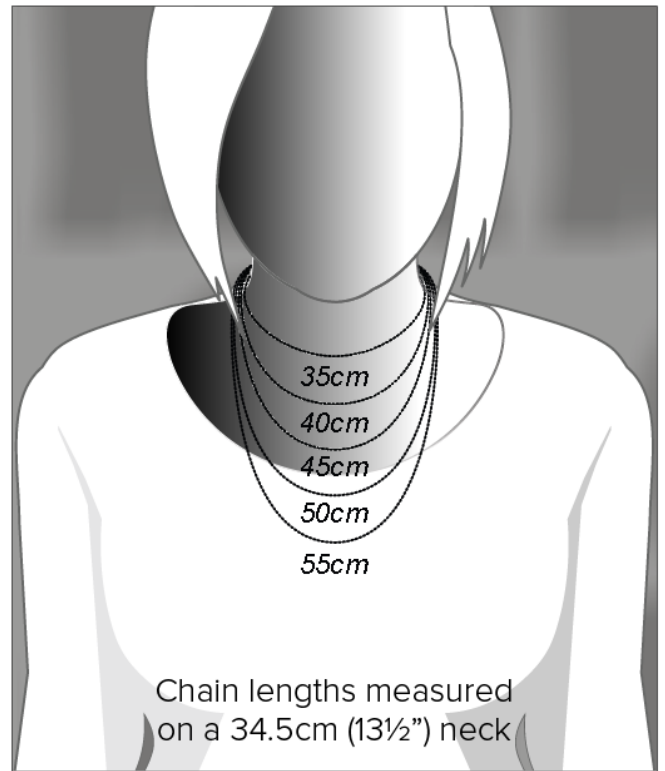
NECKLACE OR CHAIN LENGTH

Either have a play using a piece of string and adjust to the length you require and then measure or take a look at the photos below.



FOR MEN

The man in the photo above has an average, 40.5cm neck circumference. Don't worry if you choose the wrong size you will be able to exchange it for the right size if available.*



FOR WOMEN

The woman in the photo above has an average, 34 cm neck circumference. Don't worry if you choose the wrong size you will be able to exchange it for the right size if available.*

MEASURE YOUR BRACELET SIZE

Measure your wrist with a conventional tape measure.



PANDORA BRACELETS

Add 2-3cm to your wrist size. If your Pandora bracelet turns out to be the wrong size just return it to us and we can send you the right size.*



ALL OTHER BRACELETS

Add 2cm to your wrist size. Depending on the particular model we can often take links out for you to make the bracelet smaller. Don't worry if you choose the wrong size you will be able to exchange it for the right size if available.*
